

AKC rules regarding qualifications standards and conduct of the stakes is available from the event secretary. Qualifications standards are also available on the AKC website at www.AKC.org. Braces may be adjusted as necessary by the event officials during all stakes.

AKC-approved tracking collars may be used. A list of AKC-approved models is at www.akc.org/events/hunting_tests/pointing_breeds/tracking_cfm.

Bitches in season may compete in all stakes. Advise Field Trial Secretary of any bitch in season as soon as possible.

All participants are required to complete a release of liability to Rocky Mountain Roosters Inc prior to entrance upon the grounds. The Release of Liability is attached as an insert to the premium and must be submitted with the entrance premium.

Water is available on site. Indoors bathroom facilities are available inside the club house. No dogs are permitted to be off leash except during running of their brace or inside any building at any time. Electrical hookup is NOT available on site.

This is a private facility and must be kept clean. Please clean-up after your dog and horses. Use of the grounds for horse riding is restricted to the braces and associated gallery participation.

The gallery is under the marshal's control at all times.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be available in the clubhouse for the entire trial. A separate menu and information about the cost is attached to the premium. There will be beverages available through the local trial committee.

There will be a Calcutta on the Amateur Championship the evening before the stake begins.
